Ask, Seek, & Knock

On Sunday, January 15, at 10:45 a.m. we will begin studying the 17th of the "**49 Commands of Christ**" which is "**Ask, Seek, and Knock.**" Jesus Christ said, "**Ask**, and it shall be given you; **seek**, and ye shall find; **knock**, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened" (Matthew 7:8).

I welcome you to join us for this study in which we will learn about the **various aspects of prayer** as revealed in Christ's command to **not just ask**, but also to **seek**, and to **knock**. We will study the **facets of asking, seeking, and knocking**. We will cover excellent material on topics such as: The purpose of prayer, the requirement of fervency, prayer and crying out, what a cry represents, important factors for asking, how to seek, etc.

Do you know why God promised to deliver His people from the bondage of Egypt and then led them into a wilderness with no water or food. He wanted their need to draw them close to Him.
