## **Do For Others**

On Sunday, February 26, at 10:45 a.m. we will begin studying the 18th of the "**49 Commands of Christ**" which is "**Do For Others** what you want for yourself." Jesus Christ said, "All things whatsoever ye would that men should **do to you, do ye even so to them:** for this is the law and the prophets" (Matthew 7:12).

We will talk about the things that we desire others to do for us – good things like: **demonstrate love, show honor, give forgiveness, provide emergency funds, tell the truth, demonstrate loyalty, give protection, and earnestly pray for us.** The desires that we have are clues to the needs of others. We will see how these desires that we have for ourselves are the very things that we are commanded of God through "**the law and the prophets**" to do for others! The true intent of the Law is to show us how to desire the right things and how to obtain them through the Lord Jesus Christ. It is on this basis that Jesus explained that all the Law and the prophets are directly related to two commands: Love God and love your neighbor as yourself. We will see how the ability to give others what we would want starts with giving God what He wants most.

Christ's final command was "Go...and teach all nations... Teaching them **to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you**" (Mt. 28:19-20). Our objective is to learn and to obey all **49 commands of Christ!** Jesus promised, "If ye **keep my commandments,** ye shall abide in my love..." (John 15:10). I invite you to join us for this study of God's Word.
