God Loves YOU!

Has anyone ever told you that **God loves you**? Perhaps your answer was, "I don't believe that!" Oh, you may not have verbally answered like that, but in your heart you knew that you were guilty of conduct a holy God could not condone. Wrongly assuming that God's love is like limited human love, you said to yourself, "God cannot love me—I'm too bad—too sinful—too unholy—too immoral!" You were right in understanding that God will not condone sinful conduct, but you were totally **wrong to compare God's love to human love** assuming His love stops reaching out at that point. **God is love!** That is His nature. **His love is "an everlasting love"** (Jer. 31:3). His love provided a means for sinful man to be restored into fellowship with a holy God. His love provided His own Son as a sacrifice for your sins. **"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life"** (John 3:16).

You may feel that you are too great a sinner to enjoy God's love and forgiveness, but even the Apostle Paul admitted, **"For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us"** (Titus 3:3-5). **"But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved)"** (Ephesians 2:4-5).

Respond to God's love. Ask Jesus to forgive your sins now, and you will be able to say, **"Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God..."** (1 John 3:1). Yes, **God loves YOU!**
