The Narrow Way

On Sunday, March 26, at 10:45 a.m. we will begin studying the 19th of the “**49 Commands of Christ**” which is “**Choose The Narrow Way.**” Jesus Christ said, “Enter ye in at the straight gate: for wide is the gate, and **broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction**, and many there be which go in thereat: Because straight is the gate, and **narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it**” (Matthew 7:13-14).

Why does the majority choose the broad way to destruction? Among the reasons; we will discuss are:

1. Fear of being ridiculed and rejected by friends and associates. Scripture warns, “The fear of man bringeth a snare” (Proverbs 29:25). **If we are caught in the trap of what others think, we will not be free to determine what God wants!**
2. Pleasures of sin. As a young man with firm faith in God, Moses chose “rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the **pleasures of sin for a season**” (Hebrews 11:25).
3. Natural inclinations. God warns, “**There is a way which seemeth right** unto a man, **but the end thereof are the ways of death**” (Proverbs 14:12).

We will also examine the characteristics of the broad way and of the narrow way. Jesus said, “I am **the way**” (see: www.NAOG.ws).

Christ’s final command was “Go...and teach all nations... Teaching them **to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you**” (Mt. 28:19-20). Jesus promised, “If ye keep **my commandments**, ye shall abide in my love...” (John 15:10). I invite you to join us for this study.
