“Never Felt This Alive!”

A powerful move of the Holy Spirit is continuing in our church! Wednesday evening a **young mother testified** how **the Lord delivered her from an addiction and totally changed her life after prayer.** She had become dependent on a medication—“drinking it right out of the bottle” whenever she became depressed. Her addiction became uncontrollable, resulting in an arrest over a false prescription. Embarrassed and trying to quit “cold turkey,” she was troubled and filled with hopelessness since prior professional treatment had failed. Her mother urged her to call me for prayer. **In desperation she called** and as we prayed on the phone, **the Lord touched her!** She expressed surprise about immediately feeling **lighter and peaceful** and said she would be in church on Sunday morning. During that service I asked her to come forward and for others to gather around her and pray. **Again the Lord touched her and she left rejoicing.** Next morning **she awoke instantly aware of the brilliance of the sunlight streaming** through her farmhouse windows! She had never noticed that before! **She jumped out of bed** (which she had not done for years) feeling **“reborn—like a new person!”** Everything appeared new and beautiful! Excitedly she left this message on the church phone, “I never saw **such power** in my entire life as I did yesterday! It was **like a big weight was lifted** and today I **feel like a whole brand new person!** I can just **feel the Holy Spirit on me.** Since I was a little girl I have never felt this in all the times that I went to church. I never felt **such goodness... I woke up laughing and smiling!**” She and her children have been “outside playing all week catching butterflies and fireflies, taking walks and picking flowers!” She stated, “I **never felt this alive in all my years of living!** This is what I have been looking for—not something in a drug!”
