“Taste and See”

If I placed a delicious dessert before you and then used 25 adjectives to describe **how good it is**, would you really know how it tastes? Hardly! You have to **taste it for yourself!** The Bible says it is like that with the Lord. “O **taste and see** that the **Lord is good...**” (Psalm 34:8). “**Taste**” speaks of **receiving** the good blessings the Lord has provided for you by His grace! “**See**” means to “experience.” God wants you to **experience** and **know for yourself** that **He is good** even as others who “...have **tasted that the Lord is gracious**” (I Peter 2:3).
