Your Needs

The **evangelistic and musical Millikin Family** of Claremore, OK is ministering at our church in revival services continuing each night at 7:30 p.m. **through Sunday, August 12** at 10:45 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Evangelist Jimmy Millikin is preaching anointed messages like the one on **"Your Needs"** from Matthew 6:32, "... your heavenly Father knoweth that **ye have need** of all these things." He showed that God knows of and supplies our **material needs** and our more important **spiritual needs**. He stated that God knew we all needed a Savior and He gave His Son to meet our spiritual needs. Emphasizing that God knows our **distinct personal needs**, he told of a man who was recently saved out of a life of sin and drugs and attended their meetings in Ohio. After reading the Bible story of Jesus healing the leper, the man prayed, "Lord, I am like this leper. I've lost my family and everything because of sin and drugs. I would sure like to know more about this leper. If you really care about me, Lord, would you have Jimmy preach about that leper tonight?" Before the service that night the Lord told Jimmy to preach on the leper. As he explained how leprosy is a type of sin that will destroy one's life, tears began streaming down the man's face as he realized **God cared** enough for him to answer his prayer. Jimmy also told of a woman who attended their revival in Indiana three weeks ago. She was trying to keep up with household chores but had horrible pain and began crying to the Lord about her situation. Then the song "Great is Thy Faithfulness" began playing on the radio and she felt God was telling her **He knew** and **cared**. In the revival service Jimmy felt the Lord was telling him to play "Great is Thy Faithfulness" on his saxophone, but he was leery of doing so because he had not played it for several years. Then the Lord spoke to Him, "Play it now!" As he obeyed, that lady started bawling like a baby in realization again that **the Lord cared for her**.
